**SCHOOL-PARENT COMPACT**

**School Responsibilities**

Rosemont Elementary School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the state's student academic achievement standards as follows:

*Rosemont Elementary School will have highly qualified educators to deliver rigorous instruction to support the Virginia Standards of Learning while promoting a supportive, effective, and safe learning environment for all students by promoting leadership qualities and positive behavior.*

2. Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least annually in elementary schools) during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement. Specifically, those conferences will be held:

3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:

*Reports will be provided by Rosemont Elementary School by means of progress reports and report cards at least once per nine week period.*

4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:

*Rosemont Elementary School staff shall be accessible via e-mail daily, before and after school hours (at Rosemont Elementary School) when requested by parents/legal guardians and scheduled with an agreed upon date and time, via phone, however, due to instruction, staff may have to return phone calls when they are able to do so. Parents can expect return call/e-mail within 24 hours, unless an extenuating circumstance arises. If unable to make a scheduled meeting, parent must contact the school. All teachers maintain a log to document parent/teacher communication.*

5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:

*Parents may volunteer through the PTA. All volunteer arrangements must be scheduled in advance with the staff member with whom you will be volunteering for. If unable to make a schedule session, parents must notify the school.*

**Parent Responsibilities**

We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- *Agreeing to get my child/children to school on time (by 8:10 a.m.) every day that they are well.*
- *Ensure that my child reads 20 minutes nightly.*
- *Making sure that homework (if given) is completed nightly.*
- *Monitoring amount of television my children watch.*
- *Volunteering in my child's classroom.*
- *Participating, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my children's education.*
- *Promoting positive use of my child's extracurricular time.*
- *Staying informed about my child's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school division either received by my child or by mail and responding, as appropriate.*
- *Serving, to the extent possible, on policy advisory groups, such as being the Title I, Part A, parent representative on the school's school improvement team, the Title I Policy Advisory Committee, the Division wide Policy Advisory Council, the state's Committee of Practitioners, the school support team, or other school advisory or policy groups.*

**Student Responsibilities**

We, as students, will share the responsibility to improve our academic achievement and achieve the State's high standards. Specifically, we will:

- *Read at least 20 minutes every day outside of school time.*
- *Do my homework (if given) every day and ask for help when I need to.*
- *Give to my parents or the adult who is responsible for my welfare, all notices and information received by me from my school every day.*
